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Assurance System Basics



- Web-based system
- Secure access for institutional representatives (3 “official” plus 12 more), peer reviewers, HLC staff
- Maintained over entire timeline of HLC affiliation
- HLC’s Assurance System is “all that is required” unless institution chooses other systems to help it organize materials, manage a process, etc.

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Assurance Filing

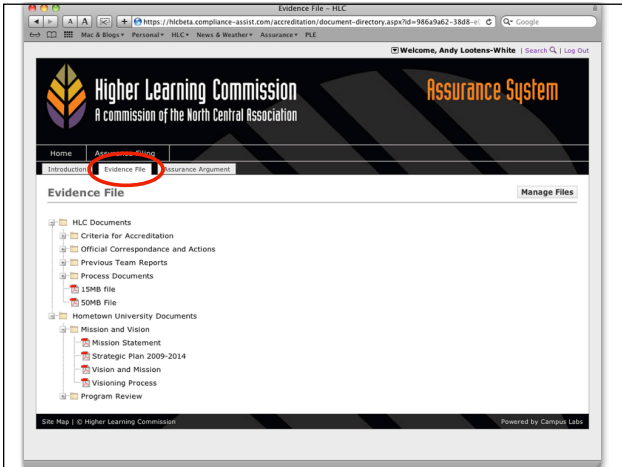
- Evidence File
 - HLC-provided materials
 - Institution-provided materials
 - Addendum space (as needed)
- Assurance Argument
- Add-on templates as applicable (Federal Compliance, Assumed Practices, Eligibility Requirements)

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Evidence File

- HLC-provided evidence is pre-loaded
- Folder and file management area for institutionally-provided evidence
- Supports PDF's and a limited set of URL links
- Upload once, link many times throughout Assurance Argument

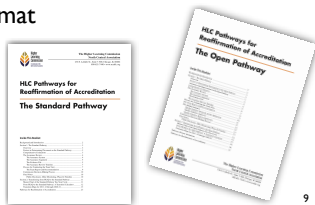
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Assurance Argument

- Assurance Argument concept replaces the Self-Study model; they are quite different
- 35,000 word limit (40,000 for Standard Pathway)
- Organized by Criteria and Core Components; highly structured format
- Links to evidence
- Additional detail in Pathways booklets

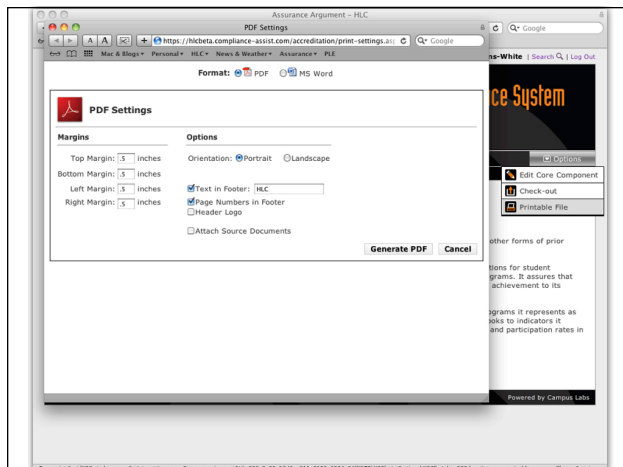
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System “Smart” Features

- At-a-glance dashboard view with word count
- Document history with change tracking
- Reveal where evidence is linked to Argument
- “Replace” outdated evidence documents easily
- Generate PDF or Word versions of entire Assurance Argument or subsets
- Assign person responsible for each section
- Built-in deadline scheduling with reminders

- Right Now: 5 Beta Tester institutions using it now
- Thru Fall 2012: Peer Review module development
- Fall 2012: Access for all Pathways Cohort I institutions
- Fall 2013: Access for all other HLC member institutions; meanwhile,
 - keep in mind your Pathway timeline
 - you may begin collecting evidence, writing argument

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Assurance Review, Comprehensive, and Reaffirmation

- Year 4 Open Pathway Assurance Review is conducted at a distance unless team requests a visit (Standard always has visit)
- Year 10 Assurance Review includes the online component as well as a 2-day visit to the campus (Both Open & Standard)
- For Open Pathway, Year 10 is a "Comprehensive Review" in that it includes Assurance Review plus Federal Compliance & Multi-Campus Review (For Standard, this occurs in 4 and 10)
- Reaffirmation of Accreditation occurs in Year 10 following the Comprehensive Review. For Open Pathway, this also must include results of the Quality Initiative.

Day 1: Morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meet with the institution's senior leadership Meet with individuals involved in the Assurance Argument and Evidence File Meet with representatives of the institution's board Meet individually with the institution's chief officers
Day 1: Afternoon	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Conduct campus tour Meet with formal committees typically led by faculty (general education, curriculum, assessment, etc.) Meet with leadership representatives from academic and student affairs units, as needed Conduct open forum for faculty and staff Meet with additional individuals and groups (as determined by electronic review of Evidence File and Assurance Argument)
Day 2: Morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Meet with student senate (or key student groups as applicable) Meet with groups and individuals from Day 1 if meetings not yet held Hold Exit Session with institution's senior leadership (visit concludes and team departs campus)
Post-Visit	
Day 2: Afternoon and Day 3: Morning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Team deliberations and work at off-campus location

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Due Process & Decision

- Institution identifies errors-of-fact
- Team revises as appropriate
- Institution receives final team report
- Institution has opportunity to provide a response
- Year 4: IAC acts to accept team report and any interim monitoring
- Year 10: IAC acts on Reaffirmation of Accreditation, any interim monitoring, and verifies Pathway participation
